

Thomas Jefferson Hospital Financial Assistance Program

Overview

If you do not have health insurance and are unable to pay your hospital bill, you may qualify for Medical Assistance, Medicare or Financial Assistance. Thomas Jefferson University Hospital offers a discounted rate to all uninsured individuals, which is applied automatically at time of billing. Our staff is willing to assist individuals with applying for governmental health insurance programs. If a Financial Assistance Application is received, individuals may be eligible for additional discounts. If eligible for Financial Assistance, individuals cannot be billed for more than what the hospital would receive for amounts generally billed for the same procedure.

Who can apply?

All patients are eligible to apply for financial help within 240 days of the original billing date. The Financial Assistance Policy provides discounted or free care to those who have:

- Ruled out all other payment options. For example, you may be eligible for Medical Assistance and will be required to apply for those programs first.
- Procedure or visit is deemed Medically Necessary or Emergent.
- Follows 2017 Federal Poverty Guidelines (updated annually):
