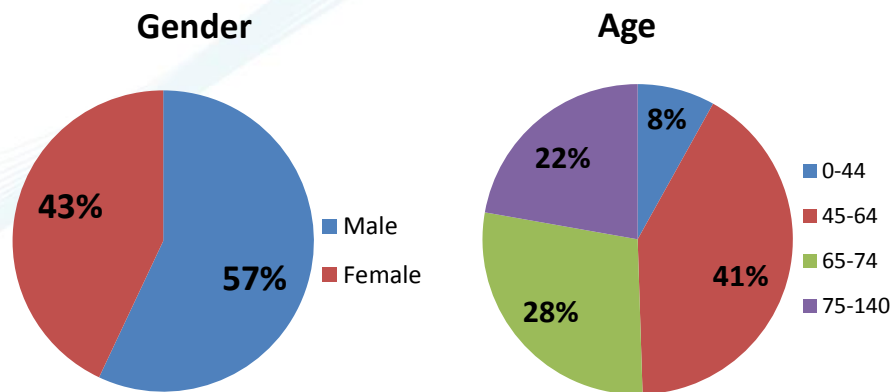


Comprehensive Acute Rehabilitation Unit Stroke Outcomes FY16

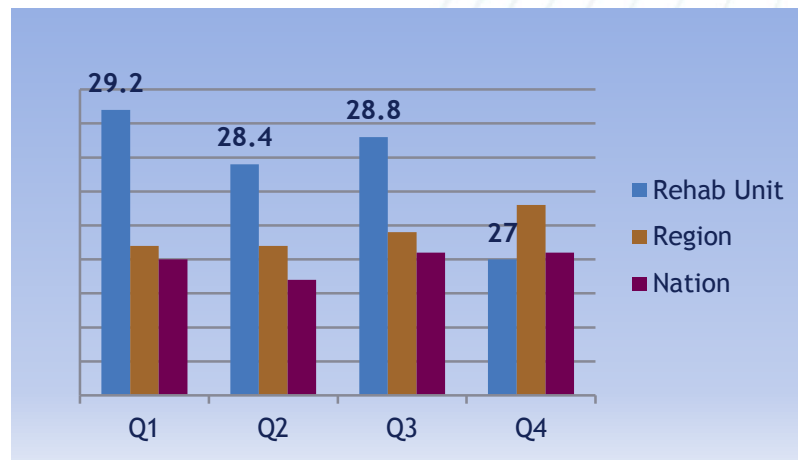


Outcomes

Functional Independence Measure (FIM™) Change
FIM™ quantifies a person's level of independence. A higher score indicates a greater level of independence. FIM™ change represents how much functional gain a patient achieves between admission and discharge.

Stroke Patients FIM™ Change FY2016

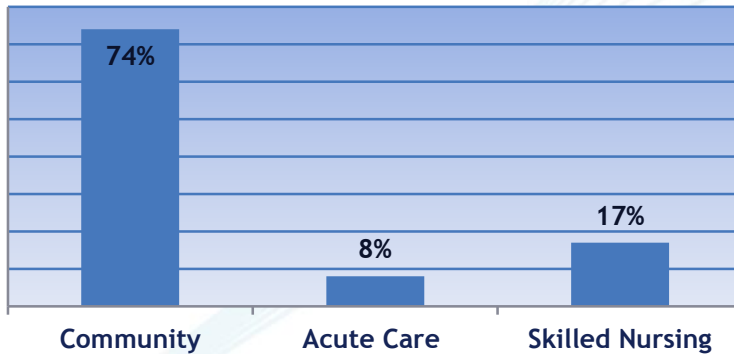

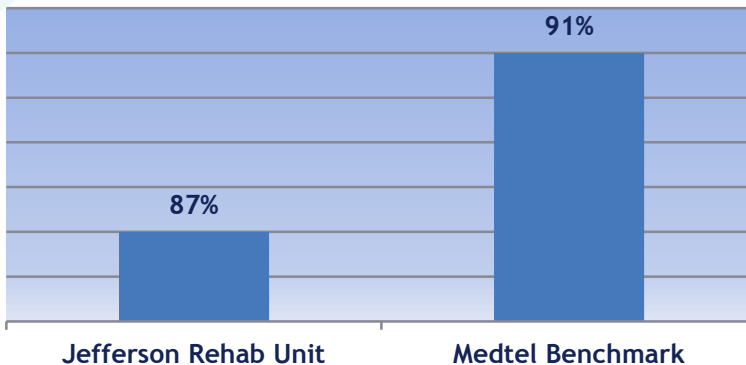

Discharge Location: Stroke



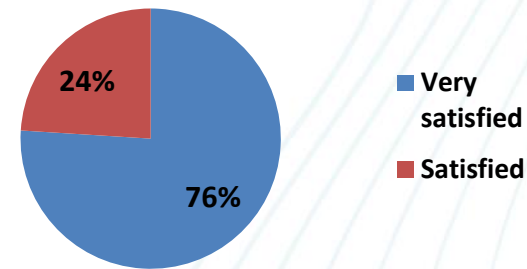
Stroke Patients Living in the Community 80-180 days after discharge
